If contact tracing is required, Public Health will be in contact with the representative

The visiting team rep must ensure they have an accurate list of spectators, players and bench staff attending any facility in Peterborough City & County. All visiting teams, including their spectators must enter the facility together.

The visiting team rep must attest that all spectators, players, bench staff & volunteers have completed and passed the City screener tool:

For games in the County, complete the provincial screening tool.

The visiting team rep must verify that all visiting spectators 12+, players 12+*, bench staff & volunteers who are attending a Peterborough City or County facility are fully vaccinated + 14 days. Each person that is required to be vaccinated must carry proof of vaccine or exemption on their person.

The visiting team rep must include a contact telephone number and email for Public Health to complete contact tracing in the event of COVID-19 exposure.

*Players 12+ have until Nov 1, 2021 to complete full vaccination
